# **Financials**

## Landscaping

For common areas, Ruppert continues to visit the site twice weekly (during the summer), once to mow and maintain Central Park (soccer field) and a second time to address all the other common areas. This month they did some additional repairs to the front side of the soccer field pathway to help with erosion and puddling, the improvement is working as intended. Berkeley staff have inspected it several times.

# 2018 Contract Bidding

Berkeley is currently collecting proposals for the following: 1) tree maintenance, 2) Town Homes and Courtyard Homes and 3) a contract renewal with Ruppert for SVHOA common areas. John Christian will collect all proposals and present to the Board for action. All bids are due the 1<sup>st</sup> week of September.

Ponds will remain with the existing vendor, Triangle Pond Management. Per John the existing vendor is doing acceptable work and it was agreed to no bid their contact for 2018. Patsy will get a new contract before the end of the year & have John sign it on behalf of the Board.

Street Trees are also being bid out between Bartlett and Davey Trees. Patsy is collecting the proposals, per John's specific direction. Once received, they will be reviewed and then passed to John for action.
