NOTICE OF STREET CLOSINGS

On Sunday afternoon, December 14th, the Fifth Annual Southern Village Holiday 5K and Family Fun Run, presented by Harrington Bank and Duke Medicine, will be held beginning at 2:00 PM. Proceeds from this event will benefit the Chapel Hill Service League.

For the safety of the runners and walkers, it will be necessary to restrict traffic on the streets where the race takes place.

Both the 5K and the one-mile Fun Run begin and end at the Market Green. The 5K starts at 2 PM and the Fun Run starts one hour later. The streets involved are shown on the map at www.sv5k.com. We regret any inconvenience it may cause, but we hope by alerting you in advance, we can minimize any problem.

We ask that you move your cars off the streets to permit the participants more room in which to walk and run. The streets will be closed only while the participants are passing and will be opened as soon as the last racer clears the area. No one section of the course will be closed for more than 30 minutes. All streets will be fully open to traffic no later than 3:45 PM.

Finally, we ask that you contain the family pooch that afternoon. Even though your dog is friendly, it would not be a good idea if he or she got in the middle of a pack of 400 runners!
